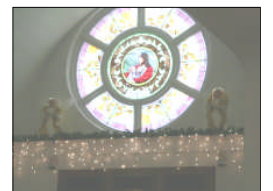

Just inside the foyer is a bulletin board with a wealth of information about the duties of the ushers.
